Converted to dairy in 2013 and having undergone a period of pasture development, the milking platform is now estimated to be 105 hectares in total including an approximate five hectare lease. The average four year production is 93,504 (2016 -2019). Presently around 270 cows are contributing to the vat, with calves going off in December and the heifers returning in May. Ground water is from a reliable bore source.

The effluent system includes weeping walls and a lined pond with an estimated 120 day storage capacity, it's then spread by hydrants and pods. The access tracks and new electric fences are in good order plus there's a mix of traditional fences from pre-conversion days.

The main dwelling is a traditional brick construction with four or more bedrooms and large living spaces. The staff home is a compact studio style dwelling, both homes are nicely elevated with views across the farm.

The Hangitiki district is around 70km south of Hamilton and central to Otorohanga and Te Kuiti, both rural service towns provide good schools and services.
